**him for he** - 35 instances (23 OT, 8 NT, 4 Ap)  
**for he feared** - 3 instances (3 OT)  
**the judgments of** - 5 instances (5 OT)  
**come upon him** - 15 instances (11 OT, 2 NT, 2 Ap)

**John 19:12** And from thenceforth Pilate sought **to release him**: but **the**  
Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's
