<sup>2</sup>And now I, Nephi, write more of the words of Isaiah, for my soul delighteth in his words. For I will liken his words unto my people, and I will send them forth unto all my children, for he verily saw my Redeemer, even as I have seen him.

<sup>3</sup>And my brother, Jacob, also has<sup>[ ]</sup> seen him as I have seen him; wherefore, I will send their words forth unto my children to prove unto them that my words are true. Wherefore, by the words of three, God hath said, I will establish my word. Nevertheless, God sendeth more witnesses, and he proveth all his words.

<sup>4</sup>Behold, my soul delighteth in prov<sup>[ ]</sup>ing unto my people the truth of the com<sup>[ ]</sup>ing of Christ; for, for this end hath the law of Moses been given; and all things which have been gi<sup>o</sup>ven of God from the beginning of the world, unto man, are the typifying of him.

<sup>5</sup>And also my soul delighteth in the covenants of the Lord which he hath made to our fathers; yea, my soul delighteth in his grace, and in his justice, and power, and mercy in the great and eternal plan of deliverance from death.
