²¹**A**nd now, behold, my beloved brethren, this is the way; **and** there is none other way nor name given under heaven whereby man can be saved in the **k**ingdom of God. **A**nd now, behold, this is the doctrine of Christ, **and** the only **and** true[X] doctrine of the Father, **and** of the Son, **and** of the Holy Ghost, which is []one[] God, without end. Amen.
