<sup>1</sup>And it came to pass that when Jesus had spoken these words unto Nephi, **and** to those **who** had been called, (now the number of them **who** had been called, **and** received power **and** authority to baptize, **was** twelve) **and** behold, he stretched forth his hand unto the multitude, **and** cried unto them, saying: Blessed are ye if ye shall give heed unto the words of these twelve **whom** I have chosen from among you to minister unto you, **and** to be your servants; **and** unto them I have given power that they may baptize you with water; **and** after that ye are baptized with water, behold, I will baptize you with fire **and** with **[X\_X\_X]** the Holy Ghost; therefore blessed are ye if ye shall believe in me **and** be baptized, after that ye have seen me **and** know that I am.

<sup>2</sup>**And** again, more blessed are they **who** shall believe in your words because **that** ye shall testify that ye have seen me, **and** that ye know that I am. **Yea**, blessed are they **who** shall believe in your words, **and** come down **into**[\_ \_] the depths of humility **and** be baptized, for they shall be visited with fire **and** with the Holy Ghost, **and** shall receive a remission of their sins.

<sup>4</sup>**And** again, blessed are all they that mourn, for they shall be comforted.

<sup>5</sup>**And** blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

<sup>6</sup>**And** blessed are all they **who** do hunger **and** thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled with the Holy Ghost.

<sup>7</sup>**And** blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.

<sup>8</sup>**And** blessed are all the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

<sup>17</sup>**T**hink not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets. I am not come to destroy but to fulfil;

<sup>18</sup>**F**or verily I say unto you, one jot nor one tittle hath not passed away from the law, but in me it hath all been fulfilled.

<sup>19</sup>**A**nd behold, I have given [X] you the law **and** the commandments of my Father, that ye shall believe in me, **and** that ye shall repent of your sins, **and** come unto me with a broken heart **and** a contrite spirit. **B**ehold, ye have the commandments before you, **and** the law is fulfilled.

<sup>20</sup>**T**herefore come unto me **and** be ye saved; for verily I say unto you, that except ye shall keep my commandments, which I have commanded you at this time, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of **heaven**.

<sup>25</sup>Agree with thine adversary quickly while thou art in the way with him, lest at any time he shall get thee, **and** thou shalt be cast into prison.

<sup>26</sup>Verily, **verily**, I say unto thee, thou shalt by no means come out thence until thou hast paid the uttermost senine. **And** while ye are in prison can ye pay even one senine? [ ] Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Nay**.

<sup>27</sup>Behold, [ ]it[ ] is written by them of old time, **that** thou shalt not commit adultery;

<sup>28</sup>But I say unto you, [ ] that whosoever looketh on a woman, to lust after her, hath committed adultery already in his heart.

<sup>29</sup>Behold, I give unto you a commandment, that ye suffer none of these things [X\_X] to enter into your heart;

<sup>30</sup>For it is better that ye should deny yourselves of these things, wherein ye will take up your cross, than that ye should be cast into **hell**.

<sup>33</sup>**And** again **it** is written, **thou** shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths;

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but verily **verily** I say unto you Swear not at all  
neither by Heaven for it is God's throne

nor by the earth for it [is] his footstool

neither shalt thou swear by thy head because thou  
canst not make one hair black or white

**But let your communication be yea yea nay  
nay** for whatsoever cometh of more than these are  
evil

& behold it is written An eye for an eye & a  
tooth for a tooth

but I say unto you That ye shall not resist evil but  
whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek turn

give to him that asketh thee & to him that

<sup>35</sup>**Nor** by the earth, for it is his footstool;

<sup>36</sup>**Neither** shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou  
canst not make one hair black or white;

<sup>37</sup>**But let your communication be Yea, yea; Nay,  
nay;** for whatsoever cometh of more than these **is**  
evil.

<sup>38</sup>**And** behold, it is written, **an eye for an eye, and a**  
tooth for a tooth;

<sup>39</sup>**But** I say unto you, **that** ye shall not resist evil, but  
whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn  
to him the other also;

<sup>40</sup>**And** if any man will sue thee at the law **and** take  
away thy coat, let him have thy cloak also;

<sup>41</sup>**And** whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go  
with him twain.

<sup>42</sup>**Give** to him that asketh thee, **and from** him that  
would borrow of thee turn thou not away.

<sup>43</sup>**And** behold it is written also, **that** thou shalt love  
thy neighbor **and** hate thine enemy;

<sup>44</sup>**But** behold I say unto you, love your enemies, bless  
them that curse you, do good to them that hate you,  
**and** pray for them **who** despitefully [ ]use[ ] you  
**and** persecute you;

<sup>45</sup>**T**hat ye may be the children of your [ ] Father **who**  
is in heaven; for he maketh his  
[ ]sun[ ] to rise on the evil **and** on the good.

<sup>46</sup>**T**herefore those things which were of old time,  
which were under the law, in me are all fulfilled.

<sup>47</sup>**O**ld things are done away, **and** all things have  
become new.

<sup>48</sup>**T**herefore I would that ye should be perfect even as  
I, or your Father **who** is in heaven is perfect.
