§ - **Omni**

Omni 1:1 Behold, it /came to pass/ that I, *Omni*, being **commanded by my father**, Jarom, that I should write somewhat upon these plates, to preserve our genealogy—

Omni 1:2 Wherefore, in my days, I would that ye should know that I fought much with the sword to preserve my people, the *Nephites*, from falling **into the hands of their enemies**, the *Lamanites*. But behold, **I of myself** am a wicked man, and I have not kept the statutes and the commandments **/of the Lord/ as I ought to have** done.

Omni 1:3 And it /came to pass/ that two hundred and seventy and six years had passed away, and we had many seasons of peace; and we had many seasons of *serious* war and bloodshed. Yea, and in fine, two hundred and eighty and two years had passed away, and I had kept these plates according to the commandments of my fathers; and I conferred them **upon my son** *Amaron*. And **I make an end**.

Omni 1:4 And now I, *Amaron*, write the **things whatsoever I** write, which are few, in /the book of/ my father.

Omni 1:5 Behold, it /came to pass/ that three hundred and twenty years had passed away, **and the more wicked part** of the *Nephites* were destroyed.

Tobit 1:8 And the third I gave unto them to whom it was meet, as Debora my father's mother had **commanded** me, because I was left an orphan **by my father**.

Judges 2:14 And the anger **of the LORD** was hot against Israel, and he delivered them **into the hands of** spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them **into the hands of their enemies** round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

John 8:42 Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came **I of myself**, but he sent me.

1 Corinthians 16:10 Now if Timotheus come, see that he may be with you without fear: for he worketh the work **of the Lord, as I** also do.

2 Corinthians 12:11 I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for **I ought to have** been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

Luke 9:38 And, behold, a man of the company cried out, saying, Master, I beseech thee, look **upon my son**: for he is mine only child.

2 Maccabees 15:37 Thus went it with Nicanor: and from that time forth the Hebrews had the city in their power. And here will **I make an end**.

Matthew 28:20 Teaching them to observe all **things whatsoever I** have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Acts 19:32 Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: for the assembly was confused; **and the more part** knew not wherefore they were come together.

Omni 1:6 For the Lord would not suffer, after he had led them /out of the/ land of Jerusalem and kept and preserved them from falling into the hands of their enemies, yea, **he would not suffer that the words should not be verified, which he spake unto our fathers, saying that: Inasmuch as ye will not keep my commandments ye shall not prosper in the land.**

Omni 1:7 Wherefore, the Lord did visit them in great judgment; nevertheless, he did spare the righteous that they **should not perish, but did deliver them /out of the/ hands of their enemies.**

Omni 1:8 And it /came to pass/ that I did deliver the plates **unto my brother Chemish.**

Omni 1:9 Now I, *Chemish*, write what few things I write, in the same book with my brother; for behold, I saw the last which he wrote, that he **wrote it with his own hand; and he wrote it in the day that he delivered them unto me.** And after this manner we keep the records, for it is /according to the/ commandments of our fathers. And I make an end.

Omni 1:10 Behold, I, *Abinadom*, am /the son of/ *Chemish*. Behold, it came to pass that I saw much war **and contention between my people**, the *Nephites*, and the *Lamanites*; and I, with my **own sword, have taken the lives of many of the Lamanites** in the defence of my brethren.

Omni 1:11 And behold, the record of this people is engraven upon plates which is had by the kings, **/according to the/ generations;** and I know of no revelation save that which has been written, neither prophecy; wherefore, that which is sufficient is written. And I make an end.

2 Maccabees 13:11 And that **he would not suffer** the people, that had even now been but a little refreshed, to be in subjection to the blasphemous nations.

Jeremiah 2:37 Yea, thou shalt go forth from him, and thine hands upon thine head: **for the LORD** hath rejected thy confidences, and **thou shalt not prosper in them.**

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him **should not perish, but** have everlasting life.

Judges 2:18 And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and **delivered them out of the hand of their enemies** all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

Luke 12:13 And one of the company said unto him, Master, speak **to my brother**, that he divide the inheritance with me.

Philemon 1:19 I Paul have **written it with mine own hand**, I will repay it: albeit I do not say to thee how thou owest unto me even thine own self besides.

1 Maccabees 10:9 Whereupon they of the tower delivered their hostages unto Jonathan, **and he delivered them unto** their parents.

Deuteronomy 5:22 These words the LORD spake unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: and he added no more. **And he wrote them in two tables of stone, and delivered them unto me.**

Exodus 8:23 And I will put **a division between my people** and thy people: to morrow shall this sign be.

Jeremiah 2:30 In vain have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your **own sword hath devoured your prophets**, like a destroying lion.

1 Chronicles 26:31 Among the Hebronites was Jerijah the chief, even among the Hebronites, **according to the generations** of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.

Omni 1:12 Behold, I am *Amaleki*, the son of *Abinadam*. Behold, I will speak unto you somewhat concerning *Mosiah*, **[which]** who **was made king over the** land of *Zarahemla*; for behold, he being warned **/of the Lord/ that he** should flee out of the land of Nephi, and as many as **would hearken unto the voice of the Lord** should also depart out of the land with him, into the wilderness—

Omni 1:13 And it came to pass **that he did according as the Lord had commanded** him. And they departed out **of the land into the** wilderness, **as many as** would hearken unto the voice /of the Lord/; and they **were led by** many *preachings* and prophesyings. And they were admonished continually **by the word of God; and they were led by the** power of his arm, through the wilderness until they came down into the land **which is called the land of Zarahemla**.

Omni 1:14 And **they discovered a** people, who were called the people of *Zarahemla*. Now, there was great rejoicing among the people of *Zarahemla*; and also *Zarahemla* did rejoice exceedingly, **because [that] /the Lord had/** sent the people of *Mosiah* **with the plates of brass** which contained the record of the Jews.

Daniel 9:1 In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the seed of the Medes, **which was made king over the** realm of the Chaldeans;

Judges 3:4 And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they **would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he** commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

Job 42:9 So Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite went, **and did according as the Lord commanded** them: the Lord also accepted Job.

Joel 1:14 Sanctify ye a fast, call a solemn assembly, gather the elders and all the inhabitants **of the land into the** house of the Lord your God, and cry unto the Lord,

Romans 8:14 For **as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they** are the sons of God.

1 Timothy 4:5 For it is sanctified **by the word of God and** prayer.

Deuteronomy 3:13 And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, being the kingdom of Og, gave I unto the half tribe of Manasseh; all the region of Argob, with all Bashan, **which was called the land of** giants.

Acts 27:39 And when it was day, they knew not the land: but **they discovered a** certain creek with a shore, into the which they were minded, if it were possible, to thrust in the ship.

Judges 21:15 And the people repented them for Benjamin, **because that the LORD had** made a breach in the tribes of Israel.

Ecclesiasticus 50:3 In his days the cistern to receive water, being in compass as the sea, was covered **with plates of brass**:

Omni 1:15 Behold, it /came to pass/ that *Mosiah* discovered that the people of *Zarahemla* came **out from Jerusalem** at the time that Zedekiah, king of **Judah, was carried away captive into Babylon.**

Omni 1:16 And they journeyed in the wilderness, and were brought by the hand /of the Lord/ across the great waters, into the land where *Mosiah* discovered them; and they **had dwelt there** from that time forth.

Omni 1:17 **And at the time** that *Mosiah* discovered them, they had become exceedingly *numerous*. Nevertheless, they had had many wars and *serious* contentions, and had fallen by the sword from time to time; and their language had become corrupted; and they had brought no records with them; and they denied the being of their Creator; and *Mosiah, nor /the people of/ Mosiah,* could understand them.

Omni 1:18 But it /came to pass/ that *Mosiah* caused that they should be taught in his language. And it came to pass that after **they were taught** in the language of *Mosiah*, *Zarahemla* gave a genealogy of his fathers, according to his memory; and they are written, but not in these plates.

Omni 1:19 And it /came to pass/ that the people of *Zarahemla*, and of *Mosiah*, did unite together; and *Mosiah* **was appointed to be their** king.

Omni 1:20 And it /came to pass/ in the days of *Mosiah*, there was a large stone brought unto him with engravings on it; and **he did interpret** the engravings by the gift and power of God.

Zechariah 14:8 And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go **out from Jerusalem**; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

Jeremiah 40:1 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were **carried away captive of Jerusalem** and Judah, which **were carried away captive unto Babylon.**

Jeremiah 52:27 And the king of Babylon smote them, and put them to death in Riblah in the land of Hamath. Thus **Judah was carried away captive** out of his own land.

1 Chronicles 4:40 And they found fat pasture and good, and the land was wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for they of Ham **had dwelt there** of old.

Daniel 11:40 **And at the time** of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

Jeremiah 37:2 But neither he, nor his servants, **nor the people of** the land, did hearken unto the words of the LORD, which he spake by the prophet Jeremiah.

Matthew 28:15 So they took the money, and did as **they were taught**; and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day.

Nehemiah 5:14 Moreover from the time that I **was appointed to be their** governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, that is, twelve years, I and my brethren have not eaten the bread of the governor.

Genesis 41:12 And there was there with us a young man, an Hebrew, servant to the captain of the guard; and we told him, and he interpreted to us our dreams; to each man according to his dream **he did interpret.**

Omni 1:21 And they **gave an account of** one *Coriantumr*, and the slain of his people. And *Coriantumr* was discovered by /the people of/ *Zarahemla*; and he dwelt with them for the space of nine moons.

Omni 1:22 It also spake a few words concerning his fathers. And his first parents **came out from the** tower, at the time the Lord confounded the language of the people; and the severity /of the Lord/ fell upon them according to his judgments, which are just; and their bones **lay scattered in the land** northward.

Omni 1:23 Behold, I, *Amaleki*, was born in /the days of/ *Mosiah*; and **I have lived** to see his death; and Benjamin, his son, reigneth in his stead.

Omni 1:24 And behold, **I have seen, in the days of** king Benjamin, a *serious* war and much bloodshed between the *Nephites* and the *Lamanites*. But behold, the *Nephites* did obtain much advantage over them; yea, insomuch that king Benjamin did drive them /out of the land/ of *Zarahemla*.

Acts 19:40 For we are in danger to be called in question for this day's uproar, there being no cause whereby we may **give an account of** this concourse.

Revelation 14:18 And another angel **came out from the** altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

Tobit 14:4 Go into Media my son, for I surely believe those things which Jonas the prophet spake of Nineve, that it shall be overthrown; and that for a time peace shall rather be in Media; and that our brethren shall **lie scattered in the earth** from that good land: and Jerusalem shall be desolate, and the house of God in it shall be burned, and shall be desolate for a time;

Acts 23:1 And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men and brethren, **I have lived** in all good conscience before God until this day.

Ecclesiasticus 42:15 I will now remember the works of the Lord, and declare the things that **I have seen: In the** words of the Lord are his works.

Ecclesiastes 7:15 All things **have I seen in the days of** my vanity: there is a just man that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that prolongeth his life in his wickedness.

Omni 1:25 And it came to pass that I began to be old; and, having no seed, and knowing king Benjamin to be a just man before the Lord, wherefore, I shall deliver up these plates unto him, exhorting all men to **come unto God**, the Holy One of Israel, and believe **in prophesying, and** in revelations, and in the ministering of angels, and in the gift of **speaking with tongues**, and in the gift of interpreting languages, and **in all things which [is] are good; for there is nothing which is good save it comes from [God] /the Lord: and/ that which** is evil cometh from the devil.

Omni 1:26 And now, my beloved brethren, I would **that ye should come unto Christ**, who is the Holy One /of Israel, and/ *partake* of his salvation, and the power of his redemption. Yea, **come unto him**, and offer your whole souls **as an offering unto him, and** continue in fasting and praying, and endure to the end; and **as the Lord liveth** ye will be saved.

Omni 1:27 And now I would speak somewhat concerning a certain number **who went up into the wilderness** to return to **the land of Nephi**; for /there was a/ large number who were desirous **to possess the land of** their inheritance.

Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that **come unto God** by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

1 Corinthians 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you **speaking with tongues**, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or **by prophesying, or** by doctrine?

Ephesians 4:15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him **in all things, which is** the head, even Christ:

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not **in all things which are** written in the book of the law to do them.

Luke 18:19 And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me **good? none is good, save one, that is, God.**

Ecclesiasticus 1:1 All wisdom **cometh from the Lord, and** is with him for ever.

Proverbs 19:17 He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto **the LORD; and that which** he hath given will he pay him again.

Mark 10:35 And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, **come unto him**, saying, Master, we **would that thou shouldst** do for us whatsoever we shall desire.

Leviticus 25:51 If there be yet many years behind, according unto them he shall give again the price of **his redemption** out of the money that he was bought for.

Numbers 8:21 And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them **as an offering before the Lord; and** Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.

1 Samuel 26:16 This thing is not good that thou hast done. **As the LORD liveth, ye** are worthy to die, because ye have not kept your master, the LORD'S anointed. And now see where the king's spear is, and the cruse of water that was at his bolster.

Amos 2:10 Also I **brought you up from the land of** Egypt, and led you forty years **through the wilderness, to possess the land of** the Amorite.

Omni 1:28 Wherefore, **they went up into the** wilderness. And their leader being a strong and mighty man, and a stiffnecked man, wherefore he caused a contention among them; and **they were all slain**, save fifty, in the wilderness, and they returned again to /the land of/ *Zarahemla*.

Omni 1:29 And it /came to pass/ that they also took others to a *considerable* number, and took their journey again into the wilderness.

Omni 1:30 And I, *Amaleki*, **had a brother**, who also went with them; /and I have/ not since known concerning them. And I **am about to [lay]** lie down **in my grave**; and these plates are full. And I **make an end of** my speaking.

1 Maccabees 4:13 **Wherefore they went out of the** camp to battle; but they that were with Judas sounded their trumpets.

1 Samuel 9:14 And **they went up into the** city: and when they were come into the city, behold, Samuel came out against them, for to go up to the high place.

1 Maccabees 7:46 Whereupon they came forth out of all the towns of Judea round about, and closed them in; so that they, turning back upon them that pursued **them, were all slain** with the sword, and not one of them was left.

1 Samuel 11:11 And it was so on the morrow, that Saul put the people in three companies; and they came into the midst of the host in the morning watch, and slew the Ammonites until the heat of the day: **and it came to pass, that they** which remained were scattered, so that two of them were not left together.

Genesis 24:29 And Rebekah **had a brother**, and his name was Laban: and Laban ran out unto the man, unto the well.

Esther 12:2 And he heard their devices, and searched out their purposes, and learned that they **were about to lay** hands upon Artexerxes the king; and so he certified the king of them.

Ezekiel 11:13 And it came to pass, when I prophesied, that Pelatiah the son of Benaiah died. Then fell I **down upon my face**, and cried with a loud voice, and said, Ah Lord GOD! wilt thou **make a full end of** the remnant of Israel?

Genesis 50:5 My father made me swear, saying, Lo, I die: **in my grave** which I have digged for me in the land of Canaan, there shalt thou bury me. Now therefore let me go up, I pray thee, and bury my father, and I will come again.
