§ - **Mormon**

Mormon 1:1 And now I, *Mormon*, **make a record of the things** which **I have both** seen and heard, and call it /the Book of/ *Mormon*.

Mormon 1:2 **And about the time that** *Ammaron* hid up the records /unto the Lord/, he came unto me, (I being about ten years of age, and I began to be learned somewhat after the manner of the learning of my people) and *Ammaron* said unto me: **I perceive that thou art a** sober child, and art quick to observe;

Mormon 1:3 Therefore, **when ye are** about twenty and four years old I **would that ye should remember the** things that ye have observed concerning this people; **and when ye are** of that age **go to /the land [of]/** *Antum*, unto a hill which shall be called *Shim*; and there have I *deposited* unto the Lord all the sacred engravings concerning this people.

Mormon 1:4 And behold, ye shall take the plates of Nephi unto *yourself*, and the remainder shall ye leave **in the place where they are**; /and ye shall/ engrave on the plates of Nephi all the things that ye have observed concerning this people.

Mormon 1:5 And I, *Mormon*, being a *descendant* of Nephi, (and **my father's name** was *Mormon*) I remembered /the things which/ *Ammaron* commanded me.

Mormon 1:6 **And it came to pass that** I, being eleven years old, **was carried by** my father into the land southward, even to /the land of/ *Zarahemla*.

Esther 12:4 And the king **made a record of these things**, and Mardocheus also wrote thereof.

John 12:28 Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, **I have both** glorified it, and will glorify it again.

Judith 9:1 Judith fell upon her face, and put ashes upon her head, and uncovered the sackcloth wherewith she was clothed; **and about the time that** the incense of that evening was offered in Jerusalem in the house of the Lord Judith cried with a loud voice, and said,

John 4:19 The woman saith unto him, Sir, **I perceive that thou art a** prophet.

Leviticus 26:25 And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of my covenant: **and when ye are** gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

Galatians 2:10 Only they **would that we should remember the** poor; the same which I also was forward to do.

Judges 21:21 And see, and, behold, if the daughters of Shiloh come out to dance in dances, then come ye out of the vineyards, and catch you every man his wife of the daughters of Shiloh, and **go to the land of** Benjamin.

1 Esdras 6:26 And that the holy vessels of the house of the Lord, both of gold and silver, that Nabuchodonosor took out of the house at Jerusalem, and brought to Babylon, should be restored to the house at Jerusalem, and be set **in the place where they were** before.

John 5:43 I am come in **my Father's name**, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

Luke 16:22 **And it came to pass, that** the beggar died, and **was carried by** the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

Mormon 1:7 The whole face /of the land/ had become covered with buildings, and the people were as *numerous* almost, as it were **the sand[s] of the sea**.

Mormon 1:8 **And it /came to pass/ [that] in this year there began to be a war between the Nephites**, who *consisted* of the *Nephites* and the *Jacobites* and the *Josephites* and the *Zoramites*; and this war was between the *Nephites*, and the *Lamanites* and the *Lemuelites* and the *Ishmaelites*.

Mormon 1:9 Now the *Lamanites* and the *Lemuelites* **and the Ishmaelites** were called *Lamanites*, /and the two/ parties were *Nephites* and *Lamanites*.

Mormon 1:10 And it /came to pass/ that the war began to be **among them in the** borders of *Zarahemla*, by the waters of *Sidon*.

Mormon 1:11 And it /came to pass/ that the *Nephites* **had gathered together a great number of** men, even to exceed **the number of thirty thousand**. **And** it came to pass that they did have in this same year a number of battles, in which the *Nephites* did beat the *Lamanites* and did slay many of them.

Mormon 1:12 And it /came to pass/ that the *Lamanites* withdrew their *design*, **and there was peace** settled in the land; and peace did remain **for the space of** about four years, that there was no bloodshed.

Manasseh 1:8 for I have sinned above the number of **the sands of the sea**. My transgressions, O Lord, are multiplied: my transgressions are multiplied, and I am not worthy to behold and see the height of heaven for the multitude of mine iniquities.

2 Samuel 3:6 **And it came to pass**, while **there was war between the** house of Saul and the house of David, that Abner made himself strong for the house of Saul.

Matthew 12:6 But I say unto you, **That in this** place is one greater than the temple.

Psalms 83:6 The tabernacles of Edom, **and the Ishmaelites**; of Moab, and the Hagarenes;

Leviticus 16:16 And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth **among them in the** midst of their uncleanness.

1 Maccabees 13:1 Now when Simon heard that Tryphon **had gathered together a great host** to invade the land of Judea, and destroy it,

1 Maccabees 14:7 And **gathered together a great number of** captives, and had the dominion of Gazera, and Bethsura, and the tower, out of the which he took all uncleanness, neither was there any that resisted him.

2 Chronicles 35:7 And Josiah gave to the people, of the flock, lambs and kids, all for the passover offerings, for all that were present, to **the number of thirty thousand, and** three thousand bullocks: these were of the king's substance.

1 Samuel 7:14 And the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron even unto Gath; and the coasts thereof did Israel deliver out of the hands of the Philistines. **And there was peace** between Israel and the Amorites.

Acts 19:8 And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly **for the space of** three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.

Mormon 1:13 But wickedness did prevail **upon the face of the whole land**, insomuch that the Lord did take away his beloved disciples, and the work of miracles and **of healing[s]** did cease because of the iniquity /of the people/.

Mormon 1:14 And there were no gifts from **/the Lord, and/ the Holy** Ghost did not come upon any, because of their wickedness and unbelief.

Mormon 1:15 **And I, being** fifteen years of age and being somewhat of a sober mind, therefore I was visited /of the Lord/, and tasted and knew of the goodness of Jesus.

Mormon 1:16 And I did endeavor to preach unto this people, but my mouth was shut, and I was forbidden that I should preach unto them; for behold they had wilfully rebelled against their God; **and the beloved** disciples **were taken away /out of** the/ land, because of their iniquity.

Mormon 1:17 But I did remain among them, but I was forbidden to **[that I should] preach unto them, /because of the/ hardness of their hearts;** and **because of the hardness of their hearts** the land was cursed for their sake.

Judith 7:18 Then the children of Esau went up with the children of Ammon, and camped in the hill country over against Dothaim: and they sent some of them toward the south, and toward the east over against Ekrebel, which is near unto Chusi, that is upon the brook Mochmur; and the rest of the army of the Assyrians camped in the plain, and **covered the face of the whole land**; and their tents and carriages were pitched to a very great multitude.

1 Corinthians 12:28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts **of healings**, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

1 Chronicles 22:19 Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of **the LORD, and the holy** vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD.

Genesis 34:30 And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, Ye have troubled me to make me to stink among the inhabitants of the land, among the Canaanites and the Perizzites: **and I being** few in number, they shall gather themselves together against me, and slay me; and I shall be destroyed, I and my house.

Revelation 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, **and the beloved** city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

1 Esdras 4:44 And to send away all the vessels that **were taken away out of** Jerusalem, which Cyrus set apart, when he vowed to destroy Babylon, and to send them again thither.

Ephesians 3:8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, **that I should preach among** the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

Jeremiah 26:3 If so be they will hearken, and turn every man from his evil way, that I may repent me of the evil, which I purpose to do **unto them because of the** evil of their doings.

Ecclesiasticus 16:10 Nor the six hundred thousand footmen, who were gathered together in **the hardness of their hearts**.

Mormon 1:18 And these *Gadianton* robbers, who were among the *Lamanites*, did *infest* the land, **insomuch that the inhabitants thereof** began to hide up their treasures in /the earth; and/ they became slippery, **because the Lord had cursed the land**, that they could not hold them, nor retain them again.

Mormon 1:19 **And it /came to pass/ that there were** sorceries, and witchcrafts, and *magics*; **and the power of the evil one was wrought upon all the [land] face of the land**, even unto the fulfilling of all the words of *Abinadi*, and also Samuel the *Lamanite*.

Mormon 2:1 And it /came to pass/ in that same year there began to be a war again between the *Nephites* and the *Lamanites*. And notwithstanding I being young, was large in stature; therefore the people of Nephi appointed **me that I should be their leader**, or the **leader of their armies**.

Mormon 2:2 Therefore it /came to pass/ that in my sixteenth year **I did go forth at** the head of an army of the *Nephites*, against the *Lamanites*; therefore three hundred and twenty and six years had passed away.

Mormon 2:3 And it /came to pass/ that in the three hundred and twenty and seventh year the *Lamanites* did come upon us **with [exceeding]** exceedingly **great** power, insomuch that they did *frighten* my armies; **therefore they would not** fight, and they began to *retreat towards* the north countries.

1 Maccabees 1:38 **Insomuch that the inhabitants of** Jerusalem fled because of them: whereupon the city was made an habitation of strangers, and became strange to those that were born in her; and her own children left her.

Genesis 5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, This same shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, **because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed**.

Luke 5:17 **And it came to pass** on a certain day, as he was teaching, **that there were** Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judæa, and Jerusalem: **and the power of the** Lord was present to heal them.

Deuteronomy 11:25 There shall no man be able to stand before you: for the Lord your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you **upon all the land** that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.

Ezekiel 34:6 My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered **upon all the face of the earth**, and none did search or seek after them.

1 Kings 14:2 And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there is Ahijah the prophet, which told **me that I should be king** over this people.

2 Maccabees 10:28 Now the sun being newly risen, they joined both together; the one part having together with their virtue their refuge also unto the Lord for a pledge of their success and victory: the other side making their rage **leader of their battle**.

Ezekiel 12:4 Then shalt thou bring forth thy stuff by day in their sight, as stuff for removing: and thou **shalt go forth at** even in their sight, as they that go forth into captivity.

Matthew 2:10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced **with exceeding great** joy.

2 Maccabees 8:26 For it was the day before the sabbath, and **therefore they would no** longer pursue them.

Mormon 2:4 And it came to pass that we did come to the city of *Angola[h]*, and we did take possession **of the city, and make** preparations to defend ourselves against the *Lamanites*. And it came to pass that we did fortify **the city with [all-#]** our might[s]; but notwithstanding all our *fortifications* the *Lamanites* did come upon us and did drive **us /out of the/ city.**

Mormon 2:5 And they did also drive **us forth /out of the/ land of** David.

Mormon 2:6 And we marched forth **and came to /the land of/** Joshua, **which was in the borders west by the seashore.**

Mormon 2:7 And it /came to pass/ that we did gather in our people **as fast as** it were possible, that we **might get them together in one** body.

Mormon 2:8 But behold, the land was filled with robbers and with *Lamanites*; and notwithstanding the great destruction which *hung* over my people, they did not repent of their evil doings; therefore **there was blood** and *carnage* spread **throughout all the face /of the land/,** both on the part of the *Nephites* and also on the part of the *Lamanites*; and **it was one** complete *revolution* **throughout all the face of the land.**

1 Maccabees 10:63 And he made him sit by himself, and said into his princes, Go with him into the midst **of the city, and make** proclamation, that no man complain against him of any matter, and that no man trouble him for any manner of cause.

Amos 6:8 The Lord God hath sworn by himself, saith the Lord the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will I deliver up **the city with all** that is therein.

2 Samuel 18:3 But the people answered, Thou shalt not go forth: for if we flee away, they will not care for us; neither if half of us die, will they care for us: but now thou art worth ten thousand of us: therefore now it is better that thou succour **us out of the city.**

Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, Because the LORD hated us, he hath brought **us forth out of the land of** Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Jeremiah 40:12 Even all the Jews returned out of all places whither they were driven, **and came to the land of** Judah, to Gedaliah, unto Mizpah, and gathered wine and summer fruits very much.

Numbers 22:36 And when Balak heard that Balaam was come, he went out to meet him unto a city of Moab, **which is in the border** of Arnon, which is **in the utmost coast.**

2 Esdras 2:15 Mother, embrace thy children, and bring them up with gladness, make their feet **as fast as** a pillar: for I have chosen thee, saith the Lord.

Ephesians 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he **might gather together in one** all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

Exodus 7:21 And the fish that was in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and **there was blood throughout all the land** of Egypt.

Exodus 37:22 Their knops and their branches were of the same: all of **it was one** beaten work of pure gold.

Mormon 2:9 And now, the *Lamanites* **had a king**, and his name was Aaron; and he came against us with an army of forty and four thousand. And behold, **I withstood him** with forty and two thousand. And it /came to pass/ that I **beat him with** my army that he fled before me. And behold, **all this was done**, and **three hundred and thirty** years had passed away.

Mormon 2:10 And it /came to pass/ that the *Nephites* began to repent **of their iniquity[s], and began to cry** even as had been prophesied by Samuel the prophet; for behold no man could keep that which was his own, for the thieves, and the robbers, and the murderers, and the *magic* art, and the witchcraft **which was in the land**.

Mormon 2:11 Thus there began to be a mourning and a lamentation in all the land **because of these things**, and more especially among /the people of/ Nephi.

Mormon 2:12 And it came to pass that when I, *Mormon*, saw their lamentation and their mourning and their sorrow before **the Lord, my heart** did begin to rejoice within me, knowing the mercies and **the long-suffering /of the Lord/**, therefore **supposing that he** would be merciful unto them that they would again become a righteous people.

Revelation 9:11 And they **had a king** over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.

Galatians 2:11 But when Peter was come to Antioch, **I withstood him** to the face, because he was to be blamed.

Proverbs 23:14 Thou shalt **beat him with** the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.

Matthew 1:22 Now **all this was done**, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

1 Esdras 5:23 The sons of Annas, three thousand **three hundred and thirty**.

Ezekiel 43:10 Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed **of their iniquities: and** let them measure the pattern.

Tobit 2:13 And when it was in my house, **and began to cry**, I said unto her, From whence is this kid? is it not stolen? render it to the owners; for it is not lawful to eat any thing that is stolen.

1 Kings 4:19 Geber the son of Uri was in the country of Gilead, in the country of Sihon king of the Amorites, and of Og king of Bashan; and he was the only officer **which was in the land**.

Ecclesiasticus 34:12 I was oftentimes in danger of death: yet I was delivered **because of these things**.

Psalms 84:2 My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts **of the LORD: my heart** and my flesh crieth out for the living God.

2 Peter 3:15 And account that **the longsuffering of our Lord** is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

2 Maccabees 4:32 Now Menelaus, **supposing that he** had gotten a convenient time, stole certain vessels of gold out of the temple, and gave some of them to Andronicus, and some he sold into Tyrus and the cities round about.

Mormon 2:13 But behold **this my joy** was vain, for their sorrowing was not **unto repentance, /because of the/ goodness of God;** but it was rather the sorrowing of the damned, **because the Lord would** not always suffer them to take *happiness* in sin.

Mormon 2:14 And they did not come unto Jesus with **broken hearts and contrite spirits**, but they did **curse God, and wish to die**. Nevertheless they would *struggle /with the sword/* for their lives.

Mormon 2:15 And it /came to pass/ that my sorrow did return unto me again, and I saw that the day of grace was passed with them, both *temporally* and spiritually; for I saw thousands of them hewn down in open rebellion against their God, **and heaped up as dung upon the face of the land**. And thus three hundred and forty and four years had passed away.

Mormon 2:16 And it came to pass that in the three hundred and forty and fifth year the *Nephites* did begin to flee before the *Lamanites*; and they were pursued until they came even to /the land of/ *Jashon*, before **it [were]** was **possible to stop them** in their *retreat*.

John 3:29 He that hath the bride is the bridegroom: but the friend of the bridegroom, which standeth and heareth him, rejoiceth greatly **because of the** bridegroom's voice: **this my joy** therefore is fulfilled.

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water **unto repentance**: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Romans 2:4 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that **the goodness of God** leadeth thee to **repentance**?

1 Samuel 2:25 If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall intreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, **because the LORD would** slay them.

Psalms 34:18 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a **broken heart; and** saveth such as be of a **contrite spirit**.

Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? **curse God, and die**.

Zechariah 9:3 And Tyrus did build herself a strong hold, **and heaped up** silver as the dust, and fine gold as the mire of the streets.

2 Kings 9:37 And the carcase of Jezebel shall be **as dung upon the face of the field** in the portion of Jezreel; so that they shall not say, This is Jezebel.

Acts 27:39 And when it was day, they knew not the land: but they discovered a certain creek with a shore, into the which they were minded, if **it were possible, to** thrust in the ship.

Judith 4:7 Charging them to keep the passages of the hill country: for by them there was an entrance into Judea, and it was easy **to stop them** that would come up, because the passage was straight, for two men at the most.

Mormon 2:17 And now, the city of *Jashon* was near the land where *Ammaron* had *deposited* the records /unto **the Lord**/, **that they might not be destroyed.** **And** behold I had gone according to the word of *Ammaron*, and taken the plates of Nephi, and did make a record according to the words of *Ammaron*.

Mormon 2:18 **And upon the plates of Nephi** I did make a full account /of all the/ wickedness and abominations; but upon these plates I did forbear to make a full account of their wickedness and abominations, for behold, a continual *scene* of wickedness **and abominations** has been **before mine eyes** ever since I have been sufficient to behold **the ways of man.**

Mormon 2:19 And **wo[e] is me** because of their wickedness; for my heart has been filled with sorrow because of their wickedness, all my days; nevertheless, **I know that I shall be** lifted up at the last day.

Mormon 2:20 And it /came to pass/ that in this year the people of Nephi again were hunted and driven. And it came to pass that **we were driven** forth until we had come **northward to the** land which was called Shem.

Mormon 2:21 And it /came to pass/ that we did **fortify the city** of Shem, and we did gather in our people as much as it were possible, that perhaps we might save them from destruction.

2 Maccabees 10:4 When that was done, they fell flat down, and besought **the Lord that they might** come no more into such troubles; but if they sinned any more against him, that he himself would chasten them with mercy, and **that they might not be** delivered unto the blasphemous and barbarous nations.

Daniel 6:26 I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which **shall not be destroyed, and** his dominion shall be even unto the end.

1 Kings 7:36 **For on the plates of** the ledges thereof, and on the borders thereof, he graved cherubims, lions, and palm trees, according to the proportion of every one, and additions round about.

Revelation 17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS **AND ABOMINATIONS** OF THE EARTH.

Proverbs 5:21 For **the ways of man are before the eyes** of the LORD, and he pondereth all his goings.

Psalms 120:5 **Woe is me**, that I sojourn in Mesech, that I dwell in the tents of Kedar!

Job 13:18 Behold now, I have ordered my cause; **I know that I shall be** justified.

Acts 27:27 But when the fourteenth night was come, **as we were driven** up and down in Adria, about midnight the shipmen deemed that they drew near to some country;

Ezekiel 48:1 Now these are the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus **northward, to the** coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east and west; a portion for Dan.

Judges 9:31 And he sent messengers unto Abimelech privily, saying, Behold, Gaal the son of Ebed and his brethren be come to Shechem; and, behold, they **fortify the city** against thee.

Mormon 2:22 And it /came to pass/ in the three hundred and forty and sixth year they began **to come upon us** again.

Mormon 2:23 And it /came to pass/ that I did speak unto my people, and did urge them with great *energy*, that they would stand boldly before the *Lamanites* and fight **for their wives, and their children**, and their houses, and their *homes*.

Mormon 2:24 And my words did *arouse* them somewhat to *vigor*, insomuch that they did not flee /from before the/ *Lamanites*, but did stand **with boldness** against them.

Mormon 2:25 And it /came to pass/ that we did contend with an army of thirty thousand against an army of fifty thousand. And it came to pass that we **did stand before them** with such *firmness* that they did flee from before us.

Mormon 2:26 And **it came to pass that when** they had fled we did pursue them with our armies, and did meet them again, and did beat them; nevertheless the strength /of the Lord/ **was not with us**; yea, we were left to ourselves, that the Spirit of the Lord did not abide in us; therefore we had become weak like unto our brethren.

Mormon 2:27 And my heart did sorrow because of this the great calamity /of my people/, because of their wickedness and their abominations. But behold, we did go forth against the *Lamanites* and **the robbers of Gadianton**, until we had again taken possession of the lands of our inheritance.

Mormon 2:28 And the three **hundred and forty and ninth year** had passed away. /And in the/ three hundred and fiftieth year we made a *treaty* with the *Lamanites* and the robbers of *Gadianton*, **in [the] which we** did get the lands of our inheritance divided.

Mormon 2:29 And the *Lamanites* did **give unto us the land** northward, yea, even to the narrow passage which led /into the land/ southward. And we did give unto the *Lamanites* all the land southward.

2 Kings 7:6 For the Lord had made the host of the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses, even the noise of a great host: and they said one to another, Lo, the king of Israel hath hired against us the kings of the Hittites, and the kings of the Egyptians, **to come upon us**.

Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God **with boldness**.

Ezekiel 44:11 Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, having charge at the gates of the house, and ministering to the house: they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they **shall stand before them** to minister unto them.

Genesis 44:31 **It shall come to pass, when** he seeth that the lad **is not with us**, that he will die: and thy servants shall bring down the gray hairs of thy servant our father with sorrow to the grave.

Daniel 11:14 And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also **the robbers of** thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall.

2 Maccabees 13:1 In the **hundred forty and ninth year** it was told Judas, that Antiochus Eupator was coming with a great power into Judea,

Exodus 12:51 **And it came to pass** the selfsame day, **that the LORD did** bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt by their armies.

1 Kings 13:22 But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the **which the LORD did say** to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will **build my church; and** the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

1 Maccabees 9:68 And fought against Bacchides, who was discomfited by them, and they afflicted him sore: for his counsel and travail **was in vain**.

Matthew 23:22 And he that **shall swear by heaven, sweareth by the throne of God**, and by him that sitteth thereon.

1 Kings 8:44 If thy people **go out to battle against their enemy**, whithersoever thou shalt send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward the house that I have built for thy name:

Judith 15:4 Then sent Ozias to Betomasthem, and to Bebai, and Chobai, and Cola and to all the coasts of Israel, such as should tell the things that were done, and that all should rush **forth upon their enemies to destroy** them.

Acts 7:31 When Moses saw it, he wondered at the sight: and as he drew near to behold it, **the voice of the Lord came unto** him,

Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, **Vengeance is mine; I will repay**, saith the Lord.

Job 21:3 Suffer me that I may speak; and **after that I have** spoken, mock on.

Jeremiah 32:16 Now when **I had delivered** the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, I prayed unto the LORD, saying,

1 Kings 8:38 What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all thy **people Israel, which shall** know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

John 9:27 He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also **be his disciples**?

Romans 2:12 For as many as have sinned without law **shall also** perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law **shall be judged by the law**;

Genesis 41:3 And, behold, seven other kine came up after them out of the river, ill favoured and leanfleshed; and stood **by the other** kine upon the brink of the river.

1 John 5:13 **These things have I written unto you that** believe on the name of the Son of God; **that ye may know that ye** have eternal life, and **that ye may** believe on the name of the Son of God.

Mark 1:1 The beginning of **the gospel of Jesus Christ**, the Son of God;

Acts 10:39 And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of **the Jews**, and in Jerusalem; **whom they slew** and hanged on a tree:

1 Thessalonians 5:23 **And the very God** of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Judith 11:21 There is not such a woman from one **end of the earth to** the other, both for beauty of face, and wisdom of words.

1 Esdras 5:1 After this were the principal men of the families chosen according to their tribes, to **go up with their** wives and sons and daughters, with their menservants and maidservants, and their cattle.

Numbers 33:1 These are the journeys of the children of Israel, which went forth **out of the land of** Egypt **with their armies** under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

1 Samuel 17:1 Now the Philistines **gathered together their armies to battle**, and were gathered together at Shochoh, which belongeth to Judah, and pitched between Shochoh and Azekah, in Ephesdammim.

1 Maccabees 9:17 Whereupon there was **a sore battle, insomuch** as **many were slain** on both parts.

1 Samuel 26:5 And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul **lay in the** trench, and the people pitched round about him.

Mormon 4:6 **And it /came to pass/** that the *Lamanites* did make **preparations to come against the city Teancum.**

Mormon 4:7 **And it /came to pass/** in the three hundred and sixty and fourth year the *Lamanites* did come against the city *Teancum*, that they might **take possession of the city Teancum** also.

Mormon 4:9 And now /all these things/ had been done, and there had been **thousands slain on both sides**, both the *Nephites* and the *Lamanites*.

Hebrews 10:2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? **because that the** worshippers once purged **should have had no** more conscience of sins.

Genesis 41:32 And **for that the** dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; **it is because the** thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.

Isaiah 64:7 And there is none that calleth upon thy name, **that stirreth up** himself to take hold of thee: for thou hast hid thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities.

Ezekiel 38:18 **And it shall come to pass** at the same time when Gog shall **come against the** land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face.

Proverbs 16:1 The **preparations** of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the Lord.

1 Kings 21:15 **And it came to pass**, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, **take possession of the** vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

1 Chronicles 19:6 **And when the** children of Ammon **saw that they had** made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.

Judith 2:5 Thus saith the great king, the lord of the whole earth, Behold, thou shalt go forth from my presence, and take with thee men that **trust in their own strength**, of footmen an hundred and twenty thousand; and the number of horses with their riders twelve thousand.

1 Maccabees 9:17 Whereupon there was a sore battle, insomuch as **many were slain on both parts.**

Mormon 4:11 And it is impossible for the tongue to describe, or for man to write a perfect **description of the** horrible *scene* of the blood and *carnage* which was among the people, both of the *Nephites* /and of the/ *Lamanites*; **and every heart** was hardened, so that they delighted in the **shedding of blood** continually.

Mormon 4:12 And there never had been so great wickedness among all **the children of Lehi**, nor even among all the house of Israel, **according to the words /of the Lord/**, as was among this people.

Mormon 4:13 **And it /came to pass/** that the *Lamanites* did **take possession of** the city Desolation, and this because their number did exceed the number of the *Nephites*.

Revelation 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet **repented not of the works of their hands**, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

Jeremiah 51:24 And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their **evil that they have done** in Zion in your sight, saith the LORD.

Genesis 6:5 And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only **evil continually**.

Hebrews 6:4 For **it is impossible for** those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

1 Esdras 5:39 And when the **description of the** kindred of these men was sought in the register, and was not found, they were removed from executing the office of the priesthood:

Ezekiel 21:7 And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: **and every heart** shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak as water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord GOD.

Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without **shedding of blood** is no remission.

Numbers 36:5 And Moses commanded **the children of Israel according to the word of the LORD**, saying, The tribe of the sons of Joseph hath said well.

1 Kings 21:16 **And it came to pass**, when Ahab heard that Naboth was dead, that Ahab rose up to go down to the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, to **take possession of it**.

Matthew 5:20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness **shall exceed the** righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Mormon 4:15 And it /came to pass/ that in the three hundred and sixty and seventh year, the *Nephites* being angry because the *Lamanites* had sacrificed their women and their children, that they did go against the *Lamanites* with exceedingly great anger, insomuch that they did beat again the *Lamanites*, **and drive them out** of their lands.

Mormon 4:16 And the *Lamanites* did **not come again** against the *Nephites* until the /three hundred and/ seventy and fifth year.

Mormon 4:17 And in this year they did **come down against the** *Nephites* with all their powers; and they were not numbered /because of the/ greatness of their number.

Mormon 4:18 And from this time forth did the *Nephites* gain no power over the *Lamanites*, but /began to be/ swept off by them even **as a dew** before the sun.

Mormon 4:19 And it /came to pass/ that the *Lamanites* did come down against the city Desolation; and there **was an** exceedingly **[exceeding] sore** battle fought in the land Desolation, in the which **they did beat the** *Nephites*.

Ezekiel 24:12 She hath wearied herself with lies, and her great scum went not **forth out of her**: her scum shall be in the fire.

1 Esdras 4:13 Then the third, who had spoken **of women, and of** the truth, (this was Zorobabel) began to speak.

Ezekiel 43:24 And thou shalt offer them before the LORD, and the priests shall cast salt upon them, and they **shall offer them up for a burnt offering unto** the LORD.

Numbers 22:11 Behold, there is a people come out of Egypt, which covereth the face of the earth: come now, curse me them; peradventure I shall be able to overcome them, **and drive them out**.

2 Esdras 12:40 And it came to pass, when all the people saw that the seven days were past, and I **not come again** into the city, they gathered them all together, from the least unto the greatest, and came unto me, and said,

Judges 7:24 And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, **Come down against the** Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

Micah 5:7 And the remnant of Jacob shall be in the midst of many people **as a dew** from the LORD, as the showers upon the grass, that tarrieth not for man, nor waiteth for the sons of men.

Jonah 3:3 So Jonah arose, and went unto Nineveh, according to the word of the LORD. Now Nineveh **was an exceeding great** city of three days' journey.

Exodus 39:3 And **they did beat the** gold into thin plates, and cut it into wires, to work it in the blue, and in the purple, and in the scarlet, and in the fine linen, with cunning work.

1 Kings 19:7 And the angel of the LORD **came again the second time**, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat; because the journey is too great for thee.

Mark 14:72 And **the second time the** cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept.

Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things **sacrificed unto idols**, and to commit fornication.

Joshua 15:47 Ashdod with her **towns and her villages**, Gaza with her **towns and her villages**, unto the river of Egypt, and the great sea, and the border thereof:

Genesis 28:8 And Esau **seeing that the** daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father;

Habakkuk 1:15 They **take up all** of them with the angle, they catch them in their net, and gather them in their drag: therefore they rejoice and are glad.

1 Samuel 14:34 And Saul said, **Disperse yourselves among the people, and** say unto them, Bring me hither every man his ox, and every man his sheep, and slay them here, and eat; and sin not against the Lord in eating with the blood. And all the people brought every man his ox with him that night, and slew them there.

Jeremiah 11:5 That I may perform **the oath which I have sworn** unto your fathers, to give them a land flowing with milk and honey, as it is this day. Then answered I, and said, So be it, O LORD.

Psalm 109:25 I became also a reproach unto them: when they looked upon me they shook their heads.

Psalm 37:40 And the LORD shall help them, and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.

Psalm 19:9 The fear **of the LORD** is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.

Luke 11:32 The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: **for they repented** at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

Mormon 5:8 And now behold, I, *Mormon*, do not desire to harrow up the souls of men in casting before them such an *awful scene* of blood and *carnage* as was laid before mine eyes; but I, knowing that these things must surely be made known, and **that all /things which are/ hid must be revealed upon the house-tops—**

Jeremiah 42:4 Then Jeremiah the prophet said unto them, I have heard you; behold, I will pray unto the LORD your God according to your words; and **it shall come to pass, that whatsoever** thing the LORD shall answer you, I will declare it unto you; I will keep nothing back from you.

1 Chronicles 14:12 And when they had left their gods there, David gave a commandment, and they **were burned with fire**.

1 Kings 6:1 **And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year** after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month Zif, which is the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD.

Deuteronomy 29:7 And when ye came unto this place, Sihon the king of Heshbon, and Og the king of Bashan, came out **against us unto battle, and we** smote them:

1 Kings 18:40 And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them **escape. And they** took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

Luke 21:22 For these be the days of vengeance, **that all things which are** written may be fulfilled.

Luke 12:3 Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets **shall be proclaimed upon the housetops**.

2 Corinthians 13:10 **Therefore I write these things** being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power **which the Lord hath** given me to edification, and not to destruction.

Ecclesiasticus 42:15 I will now remember the works of the Lord, and declare **the things that I have seen**: In the words of the Lord are his works.

2 Esdras 5:35 And he said unto me, Thou canst not. And I said, Wherefore, Lord? whereunto was I born then? or why was not my mother's womb then my grave, **that I might not have** seen the travail of Jacob, and the wearisome toil of the stock of Israel?

Esther 9:27 The Jews ordained, and took upon them, and **upon their seed, and upon** all such as joined themselves unto them, so as it should not fail, that they would keep these two days according to their writing, and according to their appointed time every year;

Wisdom 3:9 They that put their trust in him shall understand the truth: and such as be faithful in love shall abide with him: for grace and mercy is to his saints, and he **hath care for** his elect.

Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather **are known of God**, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

Judges 19:25 But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her **forth unto them; and they** knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

2 John 1:6 **And this is** love, that we walk after his commandments. **This is the commandment, That**, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, **which I have received of the Lord** Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

Jeremiah 9:23 Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise man glory **in his wisdom**, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches:

Mormon 5:15 And also that /the seed of/ this people may more fully believe his gospel, which shall go forth unto them from the Gentiles; for this people shall be scattered, and shall become a dark, a filthy, and a loathsome people, beyond **the description of** that which ever hath been amongst us, yea, **even that which hath been** among the *Lamanites*, and this **because of their unbelief and** idolatry.

Mormon 5:16 For behold, the Spirit /of the Lord/ hath already ceased to strive with their fathers; and they **are without Christ and God in the world;** and they are driven about **as chaff before the wind.**

Mormon 5:17 They were once a delightsome people, /and they had/ Christ for their shepherd; yea, they were led even **by God the Father.**

Mormon 5:18 **But now, /behold,** they are/ led about by Satan, even as chaff is driven before the wind, or as a vessel is tossed about upon the waves, without sail or anchor, or without anything wherewith to *steer* her; and even **as she is, so are they.**

Luke 20:6 But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they **be persuaded that** John was a prophet.

John 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe **that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God;** and that believing ye might have life through his name.

Matthew 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art **the Christ, the Son of the living God.**

Deuteronomy 12:9 For ye are not as yet come to the rest and to **the inheritance, which the LORD your God giveth you.**

1 Esdras 5:39 And when **the description of** the kindred of these men was sought in the register, and was not found, they were removed from executing the office of the priesthood:

Ecclesiastes 2:12 And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and madness, and folly: for what can the man do that cometh after the king? **even that which hath been** already done.

Mark 6:6 And he marvelled **because of their unbelief. And** he went round about the villages, teaching.

Ephesians 2:12 That at that time ye **were without Christ,** being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and **without God in the world:**

Psalms 35:5 Let them be **as chaff before the wind:** and let the angel **of the LORD** chase them.

Jude 1:1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified **by God the Father,** and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:

Joshua 9:12 This our bread we took hot for our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; **but now, behold,** it is dry, and it is mouldy:

1 John 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because **as he is, so are we** in this world.

1 Chronicles 16:16 Even of **the covenant which he made with Abraham, and** of his oath unto Isaac;

1 Kings 12:23 Speak unto Rehoboam, the son of Solomon, king of Judah, **and unto all the house of** Judah and Benjamin, and to the remnant of the people, saying,

Ecclesiasticus 1:23 A patient man will tear for a time, and afterward joy shall spring **up unto him**.

Acts 26:20 But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judæa, **and then to the Gentiles**, that they **should repent and turn** to God, and do works meet for repentance.

2 Corinthians 13:4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by **the power of God**. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by **the power of God** toward you.

Psalms 50:22 Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I **tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver**.

Psalms 7:2 **Lest he tear** my soul like a lion, rending it in pieces, while there is none to deliver.

Mormon 6:2 And I, *Mormon*, wrote an epistle unto the king of the *Lamanites*, and desired of him **that he would grant unto us that we might gather together** our people unto /the land of/ [*Comorah*] *Cumorah*, by a hill which was called *Cumorah*, and there we could give them battle.

Mormon 6:3 And it came to pass that /the king of/ the *Lamanites* did **grant unto me the thing which I desired**.

Mormon 6:4 And it /came to pass/ that we did march forth to the land of *Cumorah*, and we did pitch our tents around about the hill *Cumorah*; and it was in a land of **many waters, rivers, and fountains**; and here we had hope to gain advantage over the *Lamanites*.

Mormon 6:5 And when three hundred and eighty and four years had passed away, **we had gathered in all the remainder** of our people unto /the land of/ [*Comorah*] *Cumorah*.

Mormon 6:6 And it came to pass that when we had gathered in all our people in one to the land of *Cumorah*, behold I, *Mormon*, began to be old; and knowing it to be the last *struggle* of my **people, and having** been commanded /of the Lord/ that I should not suffer the records which had been handed down by our fathers, which were sacred, **to fall into the hands of the Lamanites**, (for the *Lamanites would destroy them*) therefore I made this record **out of the plates of Nephi**, and hid up in the hill *Cumorah* all the records which had been *entrusted* to me by the hand of the Lord, save it were these few plates which I gave unto my son *Moroni*.

Esther 8:6 For how can I endure to see the evil that shall come unto my people? or how can I endure to see **the destruction of my kindred**?

Luke 1:74 **That he would grant unto us, that we** being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,

Judith 3:10 And he pitched between Geba and Scythopolis, and there he tarried a whole month, **that he might gather together** all the carriages of his army.

2 Samuel 10:1 And it came to pass after this, **that the king of the** children of Ammon died, and Hanun his son reigned in his stead.

Job 6:8 Oh that I might have my request; and that God would **grant me the thing that I long for!**

Revelation 16:4 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the **rivers and fountains of waters**; and they became blood.

Matthew 2:4 And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.

Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the **people, and, having** stoned Paul, drew him **out of the city**, supposing he had been dead.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing **to fall into the hands of the** living God.

1 Chronicles 19:7 So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and **came to battle**.

Isaiah 10:33 Behold, the Lord, the Lord of hosts, shall lop the bough **with terror**: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled.

Jeremiah 27:8 **And it shall come to pass, that** the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, **with the sword, and with the** famine, **and with the** pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

Deuteronomy 19:5 As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke **with the axe** to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

Psalms 18:22 For all his judgments were before **me, and I did not put** away his statutes from me.

Mormon 6:14 And *Lamah* had fallen **with his /ten thousand**; and/ *Gilgal* had fallen **with his ten thousand**; and *Limhah* had fallen **with his ten thousand**; and [*Joneam*] *Jeneum* had fallen **with his ten thousand**; and *Cumenihah*, and *Moronihah*, and *Antionum*, and *Shiblom*, **and Shem, and Josh**, had fallen **with their ten thousand** each.

Acts 13:6 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus:

Isaiah 33:9 The earth mourneth and languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed and hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off their fruits.

Mark 15:40 There were also women looking on afar off: among whom was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James the less and of Joses, and Salome;

Joshua 15:9 And the border was drawn from the top of the hill unto the fountain of the water of Nephtoah, and went out to the cities of mount Ephron; and the border was drawn to Baalah, which is Kirjathjearim:

Deuteronomy 33:17 His glory is like the firstling of his bullock, and his horns are like the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they are the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they are the thousands of Manasseh.

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

Luke 24:39 Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not **flesh and bones**, as ye see me have.

Exodus 5:8 And the **tale of the** bricks, which they did make heretofore, ye shall lay upon them; ye shall not diminish ought thereof: for they be idle; therefore they cry, saying, Let us go and sacrifice to our God.

Genesis 20:11 And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God is not in this place; and **they will slay me** for my wife's sake.

John 8:14 Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, yet my record is true: for I know whence I came, **and whither I go**; but ye cannot tell whence I come, **and whither I go**.

Deuteronomy 25:11 When men strive together **one with another, and the** wife of the one draweth near for to deliver her husband out of **the hand of** him that smiteth him, and putteth forth her hand, and taketh him by the secrets:

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and **the end thereof** shall be with a flood, and unto **the end of the war** desolations are determined.

Jeremiah 31:29 In those days they shall **say no more**, The fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge.

2 Samuel 22:29 For thou art my lamp, O **LORD: and the LORD will** lighten my darkness.

1 Samuel 8:18 And ye shall cry out in that day because of your king which ye shall have chosen you; **and the LORD will not** hear you in that day.

Mormon 9:14 And then cometh the judgment of the Holy One upon them; and then cometh the time that he **that is filthy shall be filthy still; /and he that/ is righteous shall be righteous still**; he that is happy shall be happy still; and he that is unhappy shall be unhappy [stills shall be unhappy shall be unhappy shall be unhappy] still.

Mormon 9:15 And now, **O all ye that** have imagined up unto yourselves a god who can do no miracles, I would **ask of you**, have all **these things** passed, of which I have spoken? Has the end come yet? Behold /I say unto/ you, Nay; and God **has not ceased to be** a God of miracles.
