

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Nephi 14

<sup>1</sup>And now it came to pass that  
when Jesus had spoken these words  
he turned again to the multitude  
& [he] did open his mouth unto them again saying  
Verily verily I say unto you  
judge not that ye be not judged  
<sup>2</sup>for with what judgment ye judge ye shall be judged  
& <sup>with</sup> what measure ye mete it shall be measured to you again

<sup>3</sup>& why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brothers eye  
but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye  
<sup>4</sup>or how wilt thou say to thy brother  
Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye  
& behold a beam is in thine own eye  
<sup>5</sup>thou hypocrite first cast out the beam out of thine own eye  
& then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brothers eye

<sup>6</sup>give not that which is holy unto the dogs  
neither cast ye your pearls before swine  
lest they trample them under their feet & turn again & rend you

<sup>7</sup>Ask & it shall be given ~~u~~<sup>unto</sup> ~~n~~ you  
seek & ye shall find  
knock & it shall be opened unto you  
<sup>8</sup>for every one that asketh receiveth  
& he that seeketh findeth  
& to him that knocketh it shall be opened  
<sup>9</sup>Or what man is there of you  
whom if his son ask bread will he give him a stone  
<sup>10</sup>or if he ask a fish will he give him a serpent  
<sup>11</sup>if ye then being evil know how to give good gifts unto your children  
how ~~m~~<sup>much</sup> ~~ue~~<sup>more</sup> shall your Father which is in Heaven  
give good things to them that ask him  
<sup>12</sup>therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you  
do ye even so to them  
for this is the law & the prophets

<sup>13</sup>Enter ye in at the strait <sup>gate</sup>  
for wide is the gate & broad is the way <sup>that</sup> leadeth to destruction  
& many there be which go in thereat  
<sup>14</sup>because strait is the ~~ga~~<sup>gate</sup> ~~n~~ & narrow is the way which leadeth unto life  
& few there be that find it

<sup>15</sup>Beware of fals prophets which come to you is ~~s~~ sheep's clothing  
but inwardly <sup>they</sup> are ravening wolves  
<sup>16</sup>ye shall know them by their fruits  
do men gather <sup>grapes</sup> of thorns or figs of thistles

<sup>17</sup>even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit  
but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit

<sup>18</sup>a good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit  
neither a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit

<sup>19</sup>every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit  
is hewn down & cast into the fire

<sup>20</sup>wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them

<sup>21</sup>not every one that saith unto me Lord Lord  
shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven  
but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in Heaven

<sup>22</sup>Many will say to me in that day  
Lord Lord have we not prophesied in thy name  
& in thy name have cast out Devils  
& in thy name done many wonderful works?

<sup>23</sup>And then will I profess unto them  
I never knew you  
depart from me ye that work iniquity

<sup>24</sup>Therefore whoso heareth these sayings of mine & doeth them  
I will liken him unto a wise man which built his house upon a rock

<sup>25</sup>& the rain descended & the floods came  
& the winds blew & beat upon that house  
& it fell not for it was founded upon a rock

<sup>26</sup>& every one that heareth these sayings of mine & doeth them not  
shall be likened unto a foolish man which built his house upon the sand

<sup>27</sup>& the rain descended & the floods came  
& the winds blew & beat upon that house  
& it fell & great was the fall of it
