**not prevail against** - 6 instances (4 OT, 1 NT, 1 Ap)

**2 Chronicles 28:1** Ahaz was twenty years old when **he** began to reign, and **he** reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: **but he did not** that which was right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

**Judith 11:10** Therefore, O lord and governor, respect **not** his word; but lay it up in thine heart, for it is true: for our nation shall **not** be punished, neither can sword **prevail against them**, except they sin **against** their God.
