#### II Peter 1:1

Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

#### II Peter 1:2

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

#### II Peter 1:3

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

#### II Peter 1:4

Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

#### II Peter 1:5

And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;

#### II Peter 1:6

And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;

#### II Peter 1:7

And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

#### II Peter 1:8

For if these things be in you, and abound, they make *you that ye shall* neither *be* barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### II Peter 1:9

But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

#### II Peter 1:8

For if these things be in you, and abound, they make X X X X neither X barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:

(For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed **his** righteous soul from day to day with **their** unlawful deeds;)

#### II Peter 2:1

But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in **abomnable** heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

#### II Peter 2:3

### II Peter 2:16

But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet.
