### Song of Solomon 5:3

I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile them?

### Song of Solomon 5:4

My beloved put in his hand by the hole *of the door*, and my bowels were moved for him.

### Song of Solomon 5:5

I rose up to open to my beloved; and my hands dropped *with* myrrh, and my fingers *with* sweet smelling myrrh, upon the handles of the lock.

I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, *and* was gone: my soul failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer.

his locks *are* bushy, *and* black as a raven.

His eyes *are* as *the eyes* of doves by the rivers  
of waters, washed with milk, *and* fitly set.

### Song of Solomon 5:13

His cheeks *are* as a bed of spices,  
*as* sweet flowers: his lips *like* lilies,  
dropping sweet smelling myrrh.

Solomon had a vineyard at Baal-hamon; he let out the vineyard unto keepers; every one for the fruit thereof was to bring a thousand *pieces* of silver.

### Song of Solomon 8:12

My vineyard, which *is* mine, *is* before me: thou, O Solomon, *must have* a thousand, and those that keep the fruit thereof two hundred.
