§ - **Enos**

Enos 1:1 Behold, it came to pass that I, Enos, knowing my father **that he was a just man**—for he taught me in his language, and also **in the nurture and admonition /of the Lord/**—and blessed be the name of my God for it—

Enos 1:2 /**And I will/ tell you** of the wrestle **which I had before God**, before I received a remission of my sins.

Enos 1:3 **Behold, I went** to hunt **beasts in the [forest]** forests; and the words which I had often heard my father speak concerning eternal life, **and the joy of the** saints, [& /the words of/ my father] sunk deep into my heart.

Enos 1:4 And my soul hungered; and I kneeled down before my Maker, and **I cried unto him in mighty prayer and supplication** for mine own soul; /and all the/ day long did I cry unto him; yea, **and when the night came** I did still raise my voice high that it reached the heavens.

Enos 1:5 And there came a voice unto me, saying: Enos, **thy sins are forgiven thee, /and thou shalt/ be blessed.**

Mark 6:20 For Herod feared John, knowing **that he was a just man** and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up **in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**

Mark 11:29 And Jesus answered and said unto them, I will also ask of you one question, and answer me, **and I will tell you** by what authority I do these things.

Judith 12:4 Then said Judith unto him As thy soul liveth, my lord, thine handmaid shall not spend those things **that I have, before the Lord** work by mine hand the things that he hath determined.

Numbers 22:32 And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Wherefore hast thou smitten thine ass these three times? **behold, I went out to** withstand thee, because thy way is perverse before me:

Isaiah 56:9 All ye beasts of the field, come to devour, yea, all ye **beasts in the forest.**

Job 20:5 That the triumphing of the wicked is short, **and the joy of the** hypocrite but for a moment?

Psalms 66:17 **I cried unto him** with my mouth, and he was extolled with my tongue.

Ephesians 6:18 **Praying always with all prayer and supplication in** the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Bel and Dragon 1:15 **Now in the night came** the priests with their wives and children, as they were wont to do, and did eat and drink up all.

Luke 5:20 And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, **thy sins are forgiven thee.**

Luke 14:14 **And thou shalt be blessed;** for they cannot recompense thee: for **thou shalt be** recompensed at the resurrection of the just.

Enos 1:6 And I, Enos, knew **that /God could not/ lie**; wherefore, my guilt was swept away.

Enos 1:7 And I said: **Lord, /how is it/ done?**

Enos 1:8 And /he [sayeth] said unto/ me: Because of **thy faith in Christ, whom thou hast** never before heard nor seen. And many years pass away before he shall manifest himself **in the flesh**; wherefore, **go to, thy faith hath made thee whole**.

Enos 1:9 Now, it /came to pass/ **that when I had heard** these words I began to feel a desire for the welfare of my brethren, the *Nephites*; wherefore, I did pour out **my whole soul** unto God for them.

Enos 1:10 And while I was thus *struggling* in the spirit, **behold, the voice /of the Lord/ came into** my mind again, saying: I will visit **thy brethren according to their** diligence in keeping my commandments. **I have given unto them** this land, and it is a holy land; and I curse it not save it be for the cause of iniquity; wherefore, I will visit thy brethren according as I have said; and their transgressions will I bring down with sorrow upon their own heads.

Enos 1:11 And after I, Enos, **had heard these words**, my faith began to be *unshaken* **in /the Lord; and/ I** prayed unto him with many long *strugglings* for my brethren, the *Lamanites*.

Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was **impossible for God to lie**, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

John 14:22 Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, **Lord, how is it** that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?

Colossians 2:5 For though I be absent **in the flesh**, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness **of your faith in Christ**.

John 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus **Christ, whom thou hast** sent.

Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him, **Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole**. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

2 Esdras 6:17 **And it happened, that when I had heard** it I stood up upon my feet, and hearkened, and, behold, there was a voice that spake, and the sound of it was like the sound of many waters.

Jeremiah 32:41 Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with **my whole soul**.

Acts 7:31 When Moses saw it, he wondered at the sight: and as he drew near to **behold it, the voice of the Lord came** unto him,

1 Chronicles 9:9 And **their brethren, according to their** generations, nine hundred and fifty and six. All these men were chief of the fathers in the house of their fathers.

John 17:8 For **I have given unto them** the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

Matthew 22:22 When they **had heard these words**, they marvelled, and left him, and went their way.

Isaiah 58:14 Then shalt thou delight thyself **in the Lord; and I** will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.

Enos 1:12 And it /came to pass/ that after I had prayed and labored with all diligence, the Lord said unto me: I will grant **unto thee according to thy desires**, because of thy faith.

Enos 1:13 And now behold, this was the desire **which I desired of him**—that **if it should so be**, that my people, the *Nephites*, should fall into transgression, and by any means be destroyed, and the *Lamanites* should not be destroyed, that /the Lord God/ would preserve a record of my people, the *Nephites*; even if it so be by the power of his holy arm, that it might be brought forth at some *future* day unto the *Lamanites*, that, perhaps, they might be brought unto salvation—

Enos 1:14 For at the present our *strugglings* were vain in *restoring* them to the true faith. And they swore **in their wrath that, if it were possible, they would destroy our records and us, and also all the traditions /of our fathers/.**

Enos 1:15 Wherefore, I knowing that /the Lord **God/ was able to** preserve our records, I cried unto him continually, **for he had said unto me: Whatsoever thing ye shall ask in faith, believing that ye shall receive in the name of Christ, ye shall receive it.**

Enos 1:16 And I **had faith, and I** did cry unto God that he would preserve the records; and he covenanted with me /that he would/ bring them forth unto the *Lamanites* in his own due time.

1 Maccabees 10:56 And now will I do to thee, as thou hast written: meet me therefore at Ptolemais, that we may see one another; for I will marry my daughter **to thee according to thy desire.**

Psalms 27:4 One thing **have I desired of the Lord**, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.

Genesis 43:11 And their father Israel said unto them, **If it must be so** now, do this; take of the best fruits in the land in your vessels, and carry down the man a present, a little balm, and a little honey, spices, and myrrh, nuts, and almonds:

1 Maccabees 2:44 So they joined their forces, and smote sinful men in their anger, and wicked men **in their wrath**: but the rest fled to the heathen for succour.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch **that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.**

2 Maccabees 8:18 For they, said he, trust in their weapons and boldness; but our confidence is in the Almighty who at a beck can cast down both them that come against **us, and also all the** world.

Hebrews 11:19 Accounting that **God was able to** raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

Jeremiah 26:16 Then said the princes and all the people unto the priests and to the prophets; This man is not worthy to die: **for he hath spoken to us in the name of the LORD** our God.

Matthew 21:22 And all things, **whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.**

James 1:6 But let him **ask in faith, nothing wavering**. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

Matthew 11:14 And if **ye will receive it**, this is Elias, which was for to come.

James 2:18 Yea, a man may say, Thou **hast faith, and I** have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

Enos 1:17 And I, Enos, knew it would be **/according to the/ covenant which he had made**; wherefore my soul did rest.

Enos 1:18 /And the Lord/ said unto me: Thy fathers have also required of me this thing; **and it shall be done unto them according to their faith**; for their faith was like unto thine.

Enos 1:19 And now it /came to pass/ that I, Enos, went about among the people of Nephi, prophesying of things to come, and testifying of **the things which I had heard and seen**.

Enos 1:20 And I bear record that the people of Nephi did seek diligently to restore the *Lamanites* unto the true faith in God. But our labors were vain; their hatred was fixed, and they were led by their evil nature that they became wild, and *ferocious*, and a blood-thirsty people, full of idolatry and filthiness; feeding upon beasts of prey; **dwelling in tents**, and wandering about /in the wilderness/ with a short skin girdle about their loins **and their heads shaven**; and their skill was in the bow, and in the *cimeter*, and the ax. And many of them **did eat nothing** save it was raw meat; and they were continually seeking to destroy us.

Enos 1:21 And it /came to pass/ that the people of Nephi did till the land, and raise **all manner of** grain, and of fruit, and flocks of herds, **and flocks of all manner of** cattle of every kind, and goats, and **wild goats, and** also many horses.

Enos 1:22 **And there were** exceedingly **[exceeding]** **many** prophets among us. /And the people/ were a stiffnecked people, hard to understand.

Hebrews 8:9 Not **according to the covenant that I made** with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

John 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, **and it shall be done unto** you.

Matthew 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you**.

Luke 2:20 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all **the things that they had heard and seen**, as it was told unto them.

Revelation 22:8 And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when **I had heard and seen**, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.

Genesis 25:27 And the boys grew: and Esau was a cunning hunter, a man of the field; and Jacob was a plain man, **dwelling in tents**.

Baruch 6:31 And the priests sit in their temples, having their clothes rent, **and their heads and beards shaven**, and nothing upon their heads.

Luke 4:2 Being forty days tempted of the devil. And in those days he **did eat nothing**: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered.

Numbers 31:30 And of the children of Israel's half, thou shalt take one portion of fifty, of the persons, of the beeves, of the asses, **and of the flocks, of all manner of** beasts, and give them unto the Levites, which keep the charge of the tabernacle of the LORD.

Psalms 104:18 The high hills are a refuge for the **wild goats; and** the rocks for the conies.

2 Chronicles 14:14 And they smote all the cities round about Gerar; for the fear of the LORD came upon them: and they spoiled all the cities; **for there was exceeding much** spoil in them.

1 Kings 7:47 And Solomon left all the vessels unweighed, because they **were exceeding many**: neither was the weight of the brass found out.

Enos 1:23 And there was nothing save it was exceeding *harshness*, preaching and prophesying of wars, and contentions, and destructions, and continually *reminding* them of death, and the *duration* of eternity, and the judgments and the power **of God, and all these things**—stirring them up continually to keep them in the fear /of the Lord/. I say there was nothing short of these things, and exceedingly **great plainness of speech**, would keep them from going down speedily to destruction. And after this manner do I **write concerning them**.

Enos 1:24 /And I saw/ wars between the *Nephites* and *Lamanites* **in the course of my days**.

Enos 1:25 And it /came to pass/ that I **began to be old, and an hundred and seventy** and nine years had passed away from the time that our father Lehi left Jerusalem.

Enos 1:26 And I saw that I must soon go down to my grave, having been wrought upon **by the power of God** that **I must preach** and prophesy unto this people, and declare the word /according to the/ **truth which is in Christ**. **And I have declared** it in all my days, and have rejoiced in it above that of the world.

Luke 12:31 But rather seek ye the kingdom **of God; and all these things** shall be added unto you.

2 Corinthians 3:12 Seeing then that we have such hope, we use **great plainness of speech**:

1 Esdras 2:22 And thou shalt find in the chronicles what is **written concerning these things**, and shalt understand that that city was rebellious, troubling both kings and cities:

Psalms 39:4 Lord, make me to know mine end, and **the measure of my days**, what it is; that I may know how frail I am.

2 Esdras 5:55 And so are they that come after you less than ye, as the creatures which now **begin to be old, and** have passed over the strength of youth.

Judith 7:2 Then their strong men removed their camps in that day, and the army of the men of war was **an hundred and seventy** thousand footmen, and twelve thousand horsemen, beside the baggage, and other men that were afoot among them, a very great multitude.

2 Corinthians 13:4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth **by the power of God**. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him **by the power of God** toward you.

Luke 4:43 And he said unto them, **I must preach** the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.

Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, **according to the** faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of **the truth which is** after godliness;

Romans 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, **which is in Christ** Jesus our Lord.

John 17:26 **And I have declared** unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Acts 7:49 Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what is **the place of my rest?**

Romans 7:18 **For I know that in** me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

Philippians 2:16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may **rejoice in the day** of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

Daniel 11:16 But he that cometh against him shall do according to his own will, and none **shall stand before him: and he shall** stand in the glorious land, which by his hand shall be consumed.

Habakkuk 2:1 I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what **he will say unto me**, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.

Matthew 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, **Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you** from the foundation of the world:

John 14:2 **In my Father's house are many mansions:** if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
