§ - **Words of Mormon**

Words of Mormon 1:1 And now I, *Mormon*, being about **to deliver up the** record /which I have/ been making into the hands of my son *Moroni*, behold I have witnessed almost all the destruction of my people, the *Nephites*.

Words of Mormon 1:2 And it is many hundred years after the coming of Christ that I deliver these records into the hands of my son; and it *supposeth* me that he will witness the entire destruction of my people. But may **God grant that** he may *survive* them, /that he may/ write somewhat concerning them, and somewhat **concerning Christ**, that perhaps some day it may profit them.

Words of Mormon 1:3 And now, I speak somewhat concerning that which I have written; **for after I had** made an abridgment from the plates of Nephi, down to the reign of this king Benjamin, of whom *Amaleki* spake, I searched among the records which had been **delivered into my hands**, and I found these plates, which contained this small account of the prophets, from Jacob down to the reign of this king Benjamin, and also many of /the words of/ Nephi.

Words of Mormon 1:4 **And the things which are** upon these plates pleasing me, because of the prophecies of the coming of Christ; and my fathers knowing that many of them **have been fulfilled**; yea, and I also know that as many things as have been prophesied concerning us down to this day **have been fulfilled**, and as many as go beyond this day **must surely /come to pass/—**

Words of Mormon 1:5 Wherefore, I chose these things, to finish my record upon them, which remainder of my record I **shall take from the** plates of Nephi; and I cannot write **the hundredth part of the** things /of my people/.

Matthew 10:21 And the brother **shall deliver up the** brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death.

Ecclesiasticus 23:12 There is a word that is clothed about with death: **God grant that** it be not found in the heritage of Jacob; for all such things shall be far from the godly, and they shall not wallow in their sins.

Ephesians 5:32 This is a great mystery: but I speak **concerning Christ** and the church.

1 Maccabees 10:53 **For after I had** joined battle with him, both he and his host was discomfited by us, so that we sit in the throne of his kingdom:

1 Maccabees 7:35 And sware in his wrath, saying, Unless Judas and his host be now **delivered into my hands**, if ever I come again in safety, I will burn up this house: and with that he went out in a great rage.

Revelation 1:19 Write **the things which** thou hast seen, **and the things which are, and the things which** shall be hereafter;

Acts 1:16 Men and brethren, this scripture must needs **have been fulfilled**, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

Tobit 14:8 And now, my son, depart out of Nineve, because that those **things which the** prophet Jonas spake **shall surely come to pass**.

Leviticus 2:9 And the priest **shall take from the** meat offering a memorial thereof, and shall burn it upon the altar: it is an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

Nehemiah 5:11 Restore, I pray you, to them, even this day, their lands, their vineyards, their oliveyards, and their houses, also **the hundredth part of the** money, and of the corn, the wine, and the oil, that ye exact of them.

Words of Mormon 1:6 But **behold, I shall take these** plates, which contain these prophesyings and revelations, **and put them with** the remainder of my record, for they are choice /unto me; and/ I know **they will be** choice unto my brethren.

Words of Mormon 1:7 And I **do this for** a wise purpose; for thus it *whispereth* me, according to the *workings* of the Spirit /of the Lord/ which is in me. And now, **I do not** know all things; but the Lord **knoweth all things** which are to come; wherefore, he **worketh in me** to do **according to his** will.

Words of Mormon 1:8 And my **prayer to God** is concerning my brethren, /**that they may**/ once again **come to the knowledge of** God, yea, the redemption of Christ; **that they may** once again be a delightful people.

Words of Mormon 1:9 And now I, *Mormon*, proceed to finish out my record, which I take from the plates of Nephi; and I **make it /according to the/** knowledge and the understanding **which God** has **[hath] given me.**

Words of Mormon 1:10 Wherefore, it /came to pass/ that after *Amaleki* had delivered up these plates into the hands of king Benjamin, he took **them and put them** with the other plates, which contained records which had been handed down by **the kings, from** generation to generation until the days of king Benjamin.

Ezekiel 37:19 Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Behold, I will take the** stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, **and will put them with** him, even with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and **they shall be** one in mine hand.

1 Maccabees 11:42 So Demetrius sent unto Jonathan, saying, **I will not** only **do this for** thee and thy people, but I will greatly honour thee and thy nation, if opportunity serve.

Baruch 3:32 But he that **knoweth all things** knoweth her, and hath found her out with his understanding: he that prepared the earth for evermore hath filled it with fourfooted beasts:

Colossians 1:29 Whereunto I also labour, striving **according to his** working, which **worketh in me** mightily.

Romans 10:1 Brethren, my heart's desire and **prayer to God** for Israel is, **that they might** be saved.

2 Maccabees 9:11 Here therefore, being plagued, he began to leave off his great pride, and to **come to the knowledge of** himself by the scourge of God, his pain increasing every moment.

Acts 7:44 Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should **make it according to the** fashion that he had seen.

Hebrews 2:13 And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children **which God hath given me.**

Acts 4:3 And they laid hands on **them, and put them** in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide.

2 Chronicles 9:26 And he reigned over all **the kings from** the river even unto the land of the Philistines, and to the border of Egypt.

Words of Mormon 1:11 And they were handed down from king Benjamin, from generation to generation until they have fallen into my hands. And I, *Mormon*, **pray to God that they may** be preserved from this time henceforth. And I know that they will be preserved; for there are great things written upon them, out of which my people and their brethren shall be judged at the great and last day, according to /the word of/ God which is written.

Words of Mormon 1:12 And now, concerning this king Benjamin—he had somewhat of contentions **among /his own people/**.

Words of Mormon 1:13 And it came to pass also that the armies of the *Lamanites* **came down /out of the/ land of** Nephi, to battle against his people. But behold, king **Benjamin gathered together** his armies, and he did stand against them; and he did fight with the strength of his own arm, with the sword of Laban.

Words of Mormon 1:14 And in the strength /of the Lord/ they did contend against their enemies, until they had slain many thousands of the *Lamanites*. And it came to pass that they did contend against the *Lamanites* until they **had driven them out of all the lands** of their inheritance.

Words of Mormon 1:15 And it /came to pass/ that after there had been **false Christs, and** their mouths had been shut, and they punished according to their crimes;

2 Corinthians 13:7 Now I **pray to God that ye do** no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates.

Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan **unto God, that they may** receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Mark 6:4 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and **among his own kin**, and in his own house.

Exodus 32:1 And when the people saw that Moses delayed to **come down out of the** mount, the people **gathered themselves together** unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up **out of the land of** Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

1 Esdras 9:5 And in three days were all they of the tribe of Judah and **Benjamin gathered together** at Jerusalem the twentieth day of the ninth month.

Jeremiah 16:15 But, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north, and from **all the lands** whither he **had driven them**: and I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers.

2 Chronicles 11:16 And after **them out of all the** tribes of Israel such as set their hearts to seek the Lord God of Israel came to Jerusalem, to sacrifice unto the Lord God of their fathers.

Mark 13:22 For **false Christs and** false prophets shall rise, and shall shew signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect.

Words of Mormon 1:16 And after there had been **false prophets, and** false *preachers* and teachers among the people, and all these having been **punished according to their** crimes; and after there having been much contention and many *dissensions* away unto the *Lamanites*, behold, it /came to pass/ that king **Benjamin, with the assistance of the holy prophets** who were among his people—

Words of Mormon 1:17 For behold, king Benjamin was a holy man, and he did **reign over his people in righteousness**; and there were many holy men in the land, and they did **speak /the word of/ God with power and with authority; and** they did use much sharpness because of the *stiffneckedness* of the people—

Words of Mormon 1:18 Wherefore, with the help of these, king Benjamin, by laboring with all the might of **his body and the faculty of his whole** soul, and also the prophets, did once more **establish peace /in the land/**.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and **false prophets, and** shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Wisdom 3:10 But the ungodly shall be **punished according to their** own imaginations, which have neglected the righteous, and forsaken the Lord.

Joshua 18:20 And Jordan was the border of it on the east side. This was the inheritance of the children of **Benjamin, by the** coasts thereof round about, **according to their** families.

Revelation 22:6 And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God **of the holy prophets** sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.

Ecclesiasticus 45:26 God give you wisdom in your heart to **judge his people in righteousness**, that their good things be not abolished, and that their glory may endure for ever.

Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they **spake the word of God with boldness**.

Luke 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for **with authority and power** he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

2 Maccabees 14:38 For in the former times, when they mingled not themselves with the Gentiles, he had been accused of Judaism, and did boldly jeopard **his body and life with all** vehemency for the religion of the Jews.

Daniel 11:17 He shall also set his face to enter with **the strength of his whole** kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him.

1 Maccabees 14:11 He **made peace in the land**, and Israel rejoiced with great joy:
