<sup>9</sup>associate yourselves O ye People & ye shall be broken in pieces

& give ear all ye of far countries

gird yourselves & ye shall be broken in pieces

for God is with us

neither fear ye their fear nor be afraid

<sup>13</sup>sanctify the Lord of hosts himself

& let him be your fear & let him be your dread

<sup>14</sup>& he shall be for a Sanctuary

but for a stone of stumbling & for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel

for a gin & a ~~snare~~ <sup>a snare</sup> to the inhabitants of Jerusalem

<sup>15</sup>& many among them shall stumble & fall

& be broken & be snared & be taken

<sup>16</sup>bind up the testimony

Seal the ~~law~~ <sup>law</sup> among my Desipels

<sup>17</sup>& I will wait upon the Lord  
that hideth his face from the house of Jacob  
& I will look for him

<sup>18</sup>behold I & the children whom the Lord hath given me  
are for signs & for wonders in Israel  
from the Lord of hosts which dwelleth in mount Zion

<sup>19</sup>& when they shall say unto you  
seek unto them that have familiar spirits  
& unto wizards that peep & mutter  
should not a People seek unto their God  
for the liveing to hear from the dead

<sup>20</sup>to the law & to the testimony  
& if they speak not according to this word  
it is because there is no liϕht in them

<sup>21</sup>& they shall pass through it hardly bestead & hungry  
& it shall come to pass that when they shall be ϕungry  
they shall fret themselves & curse their King & their God & look upward

& behold trouble & darkness dimness of anguish  
& shall be driven to darkness
